After graduating from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1985, Lt Col John Borneman served the next 11 years in the United States Marine Corps as a Marine F/A-18 Pilot, a Mission Commander, a *Top Gun* Graduate, and a Marine Weapons and Tactics Instructor. He completed more than 100 Combat and Peacekeeping Missions, more than 200 Aircraft Carrier Landings, and five 6-month Overseas Deployments that will be shared in his presentation.
